Thesis Proposal Approval Committee

Students planning to write an MCS thesis are required to register, pay for and attend the non-credit Thesis Orientation (GENR 301) that is offered at the beginning of each Fall and Winter term. ThM students are required to take the ThM Seminar (INDS 725) which is normally offered every Fall term. Thesis proposals must be signed by a faculty member before being submitted to the committee. **Six copies** of the signed thesis proposal must be submitted through Student Services clearly marked to the attention of the Registrar's Office at least two weeks prior to the meeting of the committee. A limited number of thesis proposals can be considered at each meeting.

IPIAT proposals must be signed by a faculty member before being submitted to the committee. **Four copies** of the signed proposal must be submitted through Student Services clearly marked to the attention of the Registrar's Office at least two weeks prior to the meeting of the committee. A limited number of IPIAT proposals can be considered at each meeting.
